The successful candidates will have a **minimum of 5-years child protection service experience with a children's aid society in Ontario** in addition to strong communication, research, problem solving and organizational skills; the ability to provide impartial analysis to support the development of policy and program frameworks; strong relationship management skills to work collaboratively on projects; and good time management practices and the ability to work in a fast-paced environment. Experience with provincial sector committees will be considered an asset.

What are the available secondment roles ?

- One Senior Policy Analyst to support the work of Children in Care Standards and Adoption Modernization
- One Senior Policy Analyst to support the work related to the Differential Response Model and the Kinship Service Support Model & Standards

What can I expect to do in this role?

In this role, you will:

- Apply front-line child welfare service experience and expertise to inform the development of policy and programs
- Plan, design and undertake assigned research and analysis projects, including qualitative and quantitative studies, environmental scans, trends analyses, and evaluation of legislation, policies and programs in other jurisdictions
